Quarterly Report to NCLA Executive Board: July - September 2010

On July 21, four members of the Community and Junior College Libraries Section board met with members of the College and University Section board at the Meredith College Library to continue planning and preparation for the jointly-sponsored library instruction conference that will take place on October 29 at the Davidson County Community College Conference Center. The meeting focused on selecting workshop presenters and planning conference logistics. Registration for the conference started in mid August and will continue through October 15.

The four members of the CJCLS board had a brief section meeting after the joint planning session on 7/21. This meeting focused on possibilities for a spring workshop and the feasibility of conducting it online. We agreed to research possible technologies to use for that over the next several months.

Throughout the rest of the quarter CJCLS board members continued to communicate via email. Board members communicated with a UNCG LIS professor and a librarian who are conducting research on community college libraries in preparation for a grant. In collaboration with those researches, Jason Setzer and Jennifer Noga helped to coordinate a focus group session of community college librarians to be held during lunch at the Library Instruction at the Point of Need conference on October 29.
