

## **Community and Junior College Library Section**

Quarterly Report to NCLA Executive Board: October - December 2010

The “Instruction at the Point of Need” one-day conference co-sponsored by CJCLS and the College and University Section was held October 29, 2010 at the Davidson County Community College Conference Center. Approximately 95 people attended, about 34 of the attendees were associated with community college libraries. The general consensus was that the conference was a success. The majority of participants filled out an evaluation survey. Most of the feedback was very positive. Many people also provided suggestions and ideas for future programming. CJCLS’s portion of the total conference cost was \$191.96.

Leading up to the conference in the first part of October, CJCLS board members communicated with each other and CUS members by email and via conference call to plan details of the conference.

Board members helped to coordinate a focus group session of community college librarians that was held during lunch at the conference. A UNCG LIS professor and a librarian led the focus group as part of research they are conducting on community college libraries in preparation for a grant.
